This amount represents the 2013 levy on property added in the preceding year and on new improvements that were not taxable in 2012. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll for 2013 is \$8,389.
- #3C. Proposed Ordinance providing for the assessment, levy and collection of ad valorem taxes for the City of Hedwig Village, Texas for the Year 2013 (Fiscal Year 2014) and for each year thereafter until otherwise provided; providing the date on which such taxes shall be due and payable; providing for penalty and interest on all taxes not timely paid; and repealing all ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith.
